On November 7, 2023, your community gave the City Council the authority to negotiate the most favorable electricity supply rate and terms for you. We are very proud to have been chosen to serve you!

- The program is simple! You're automatically enrolled and there's no enrollment, switching or early termination fees.
This offers eligible homeowners and businesses an electricity option for just \$0.06170 per kWh through your May 2025 meter read. Furthermore, the electricity will be 50% renewable - improving the sustainability of the City.
You should see the new price on your bill within two billing cycles of receiving this letter.
You will continue to receive one monthly bill from your local utility, Duke Energy. You'll notice that Dynergy will show as a line item for the supply portion on your bill.
