Hi City of Grandview Heights Residents and Small Businesses,

The City of Grandview Heights became certified as an electric aggregator in November 2023 following voter approval, giving the City the authority to negotiate energy rates as part of an opt-out program for eligible residents and businesses. You are receiving this letter as an eligible resident or business. The City of Grandview Heights has chosen Dynergy to be the preferred electricity supplier for you and your neighbors through its Electric Aggregation Program, which supports clean energy. We are very proud to have been chosen to serve you.

Here's What You Can Expect

- The program is simple. You are automatically enrolled and there is no enrollment, switching or early termination fee.
- You will receive a fixed rate of \$0.0697 per kWh through your June 2025 meter read for 100% renewable energy.
- Nothing will change! Continue to receive one monthly bill from your local utility, AEP Ohio. You'll notice that Dynergy will now show as a line item for the supply portion on your bill.
- AEP Ohio will send you a confirmation letter after your enrollment is finalized.
